As the month of November begins we are ministering in the New England area of Massachusetts, then on to Wisconsin, Illinois, and Colorado ministering in churches, colleges, and seminars.

Overseas Ministry:

We are in preparation for future ministry overseas in Europe. With the nations opening up to us we will be traveling from six to eight weeks ministering in conferences, colleges, churches seminars with personal ministry. When we minister overseas for about a month our expenses are normally around \$5000. For those of you who would like to be a part of sowing into the lives of others in these countries you can designate your giving towards overseas ministry.

Building Update:

We are making good progress on the building and we are very grateful to you who have made this possible. It will only take 108 partners who will give \$1,000 each through the month of December and the building will be debt free!

Devotional Teaching: A Heart of Gratitude

In Psalms 100:4 it says that we are to "Enter into His gates with **thanksgiving**. And into His courts with praise. Be **thankful** to Him, and bless His name.

Gratitude is something that we express towards others but those with a revelation of the importance of gratitude understand the benefit towards the person who expresses it.

We teach our children when they are very young to express gratitude to someone who gives them a gift as we do not want them to grow up with a selfish mentality that people owe them something. When a person gives a gift we want our children to understand that it is proper to express gratitude so that as they grow they will express thankfulness not because they have to but because it is an expression out of their own heart.

I have family in the southern states that were raised to say thank you, and yes sir, and yes ma'am. Now that they have grown up, as adults I have watched the way they relate to people and the effect it has on those who are on the receiving end. I watched people with low self-worth and there was an immediate response as they were treated with respect. As I watched I saw that because of the way they were spoken to they felt relationally safe and that this was a person who would not purposely hurt them. I watched as that person suddenly had confidence to open up their heart in response.

I believe that people can see Jesus in us as we live His ways out of the beliefs of our heart. One of the best ways to share Jesus is for Him to be reflected in and through us as unbelievers are watching us.

As we express gratitude towards God from our heart it reveals that we fully understand God's love towards us in how he has expressed His love through His son Jesus Christ. If you fully understand Jesus your heart should melt every time you think of Him in relationship to yourself.

Colossians 3:14-17 NKJV

14 But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection. **15** And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and **be thankful**. **16** Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

In verse 15 the relationship between peace ruling in our hearts and being thankful go hand in hand. We are told to let the peace of God rule in our heart which means we have a choice. We can choose ourselves in choosing our own perspective on life's problems that have the potential of dominating our heart with the bad issues of life. Or we can choose Jesus over ourselves because we understand the fullness of all the goodness of God. When you identify with good by disowning bad, the natural response should be "Jesus, thank you, you paid a terrible price Lord. Thank you for your love and Father thank you for the greatest gift, the gift of your son".

Testimony:

I am finally getting this email to you. I met you at your Friday night healing teaching in Gardner MA Charis Bible School Memorial Day weekend. You had asked me to email you our testimony. I hope your summer was fruitful. Thank you for all you do for God's Kingdom.

We came to hear you teach Memorial Day weekend 2015. I brought my whole family, but in particular my son who had been sick for 6 years with chronic, painful Lyme disease that affected both his body and mind. The last couple of years he had lived in his room at our home. We had been watching for the last 6+ months healing videos and learning about how God heals now. When we came we expected or at least I did. My son had been prayed for before so he was hopeful but not at all confident.

After your wonderful teaching my son could not even move to come up and stand in front of you. Both the pain and anxiety were too great. So I went up and asked you if I could stand in for him. I will never forget it. You looked at me and said. "That's not a problem for

Jesus.” I knew he was about to receive Jesus and be healed. I honestly don’t even remember your 30 second prayer. I just claimed he was healed after, and we left. All the way home he was in pain. But I was rejoicing that my son was healed. I had peace. Nothing in his outer body had changed when he went to sleep that night.

In the morning when he came down the stairs we saw a HUGE difference in the way he walked, talked, carried himself. We kept on praising. Second day more improvement. We kept on praising.

The third day he was completely healed.

We keep praising. Even 1 1/2 years later I don’t think there is a day that goes by that I don’t praise Him. My son has since moved out of our house, moved to another state, and has a full time job.

When you came back to speak again this past Memorial Day weekend 2016, we brought others. My sister in law no longer has tumors in her uterus which she had had for almost 10 years. It was confirmed 3 weeks later at her annual ultra sound! Thank you for sharing that Jesus lives today.

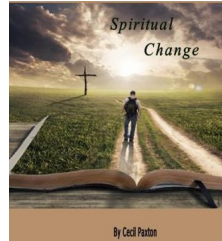

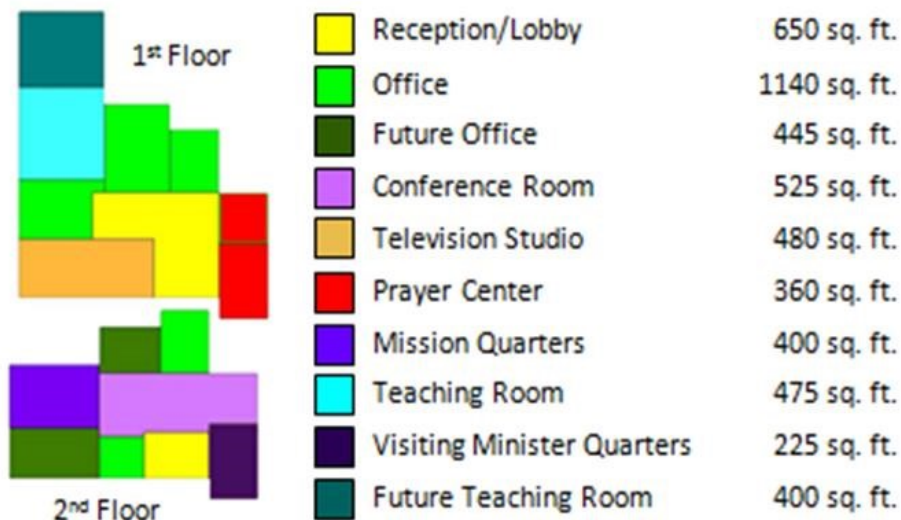
