In the month of September, we are ministering in churches, colleges and seminars in Colorado, South Carolina, and Missouri.

\$15,000.00 Summer Challenge!

As I shared previously, our pastor and board member, Lawson Perdue, came to our ministry building with a gift to share. It is in his heart to see our building paid off soon and he offered us a challenge gift. In June, July and August, Pastor Lawson offered to match all building fund gifts given each month up to \$5000.00! This is a total of \$15,000 for this matching summer challenge!

Over the months of June, July, and August we have received \$48,691.12 toward this challenge! When this is applied, the balance on the building will be around \$109,790.00. I believe it is wiser to keep the money in the kingdom of God where it is being used for Jesus instead of to the banks. As we continue into the fall months we are believing to have this building paid off soon and we want to thank all of you for your generosity and your continued support in giving towards the new building. Devotional Teaching: Unconditional Love

John 15:13 NKJV “Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends”.

A visual demonstration in everyday life of God's kind of love is a person putting others ahead of themselves. A laying down of the self-life begins and continues in a person's life by a revelation of God's kind of love.

John 15:12-13 says it this way “**This is my command: Love one another the way I loved you. 13 This is the very best way to love. Put your life on the line for your friends.**”

I just performed a funeral service for a man who in only two years of living in a new city touched so many lives that an amazing number of people showed up for the service. So many people showed up that they kept enlarging the room with chairs for more people.

This man was my nephew. We have had many wonderful conversations together over the years. He had also been listening to my teachings and experienced the Holy Spirit being his teacher by opening up the Word of God to him to the place that he received a revelation of God's love and grace.

The thing about beginning to receive a revelation is this, you will either begin to live the truth that is

revealed to you or shrink away from it to the place that you have knowledge of the Word of God but it is not a truth that you actually live.

The degree that you meditate on the revelation truth that God has given you has the potential of bringing change in your life. The Holy Spirit, who lives on the inside of you and knows His job better than you do, will get involved in the process as you meditate and He will be your teacher.

I could not be more proud of my nephew who lived a life of God's kind of love to the place that he had a value for people. Over the period of days that I was there so many people shared their own personal experiences of a loving relationship with my nephew in how his life had impacted theirs.

One man, whose life was touched by God's love through my nephew, told me that he walked out of a church during a service angry over the harsh judgmental message and that he had not gone back to any church in many years. He told me that on Sunday morning he is taking his family to a church and he knows the church that they are going to go to. The church he is going to is one that they will feel safe in because they will be hearing the right message ministered the right way.

James 2:13 says that ... Mercy triumphs over judgment.

One version of **1 John 4** says it so clearly in speaking that **God Is Love**.

“My beloved friends, let us continue to love each other since love comes from God. Everyone who loves is born of God and experiences a relationship with God. The person who refuses to love doesn't know the first thing about God, because God is love — so you can't know him if you don't love.

This is how God showed his love for us: God sent his only Son into the world so we might live

through him. This is the kind of love we are talking about — not that we once upon a time loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to clear away our sins and the damage they've done to our relationship with God.

My dear, dear friends, if God loved us like this, we certainly ought to love each other. No one has seen God, ever. But if we love one another, God dwells deeply within us, and his love becomes complete in us — perfect love!

This is how we know we're living steadily and deeply in him, and he in us: He's given us life from his life, from his very own Spirit.

Also, we've seen for ourselves and continue to state openly that the Father sent his Son as Savior of the world. Everyone who confesses that Jesus is God's Son participates continuously in an intimate relationship with God. We know it so well, we've embraced it heart and soul, this love that comes from God.”

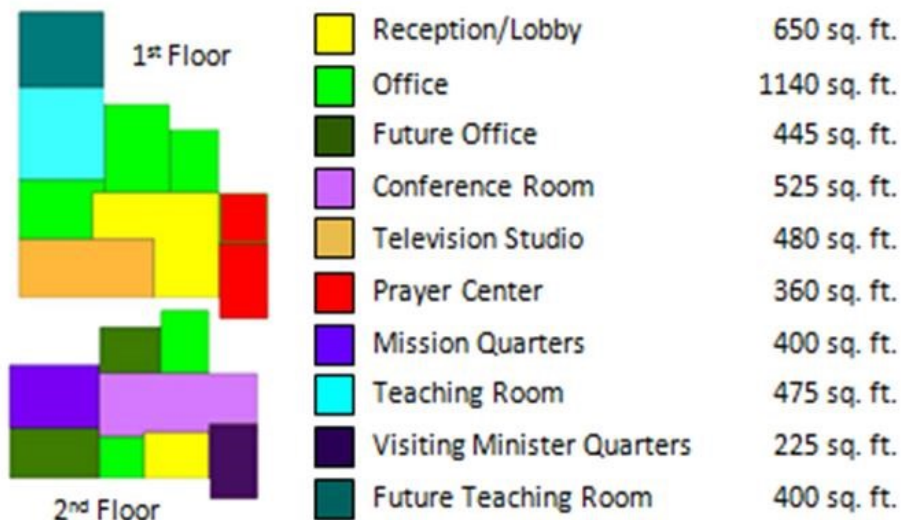
